Introducing the Queer Cripple: Shining a Bright Light on Sex, Disability and Queerness with Andrew Gurza

This presentation will introduce you to a part of the Queer Community we rarely discuss – Disabled People who identify as LGBTQ2S+ (The Queer Cripple). Queers with Disabilities are sorely underrepresented in our homo-normative, body beautiful culture, and I aim to change that.

A combination of education and personal experiences will invite you into a conversation around the Queer Cripple, the lived experiences navigating both sexuality and disability (ie. What it actually feels like to be a queer cripple), and what they can offer the LGBTQ2S+ community overall.

Participants will openly explore the mythology and fear around sex and disability, and consider why we are afraid to talk about disability in the LGBTQ2S+ community. We'll talk about the benefits of sex and disability, and why sex with a queer cripple is the best sex you aren't having. Ultimately, through frank, open and honest conversations around disability, sexuality and queerness, the workshop will provide the tools to welcome the Queer Community into the conversation around disability, and show that the Queer Cripple deserves a place under the rainbow!
